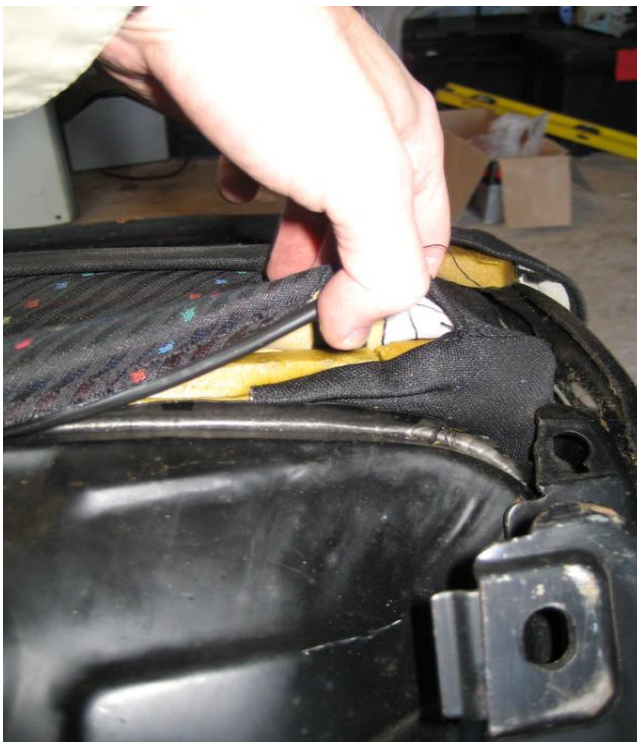


Removing seat subframe and runners

To get the subframe(s) off, you simply need to undo the two Torx bolts at the back of each runner - shown [here](#)



To get the runners off, you need to remove the seat base cloth and foam. Start by freeing up the [back](#)



with a screwdriver/pliers, then

[pulling](#)



that through to the front and then

[working round the base](#)



until it is free.

There are then [four nuts](#)



to undo, which hold the runners to the base. Strangely, just on one runner, there is also a single [rivet](#)



It might be possible to drill out, but it has been known to spin, so you may need to hacksaw through it.
